Item number two on the agenda is to approve a revised IGA between the city and DDA for 511 Reynolds Street. This is the Depot Property. This agreement will allow the DDA to come up with a proposal to develop the property and take back to the city for commission approval. The revised IGA was approved in legal last week and will go before the commission for approval on May 4, 2016.

Mr. Hutchison made a motion to approve the revised IGA between the city and DDA for Depot Property at 511 Reynolds Street. Commissioner Fennoy seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed unanimously.
